The Chief highlighted the following items from his report:

- Regarding staffing, we have made conditional offers of employment to 6 individuals. They will be entering the academy in February.
- The smart & safe funds arrived in December. We expect another disbursement in June.
- We have several grant applications out right now. We are hoping for the AFG Grant to provide funds for new ambulances.
- 8) <u>Review, Discussion and possible Action</u> to modify and/or approve the December 2021 Financial Reports and authorize the Chairman and Clerk to sign the Certificate of Review.

We are half way through the fiscal year. We have received 55% of the anticipated revenue and spent 51% of the budget. Clerk Neilson motioned to approve the December 2021 financial reports and authorize the Chairman and clerk to sign the *Certificate of Review*. Director Haffner seconded. *Motion carried unanimously*, 3:0.

9) <u>Review, Discussion and possible Action</u> to reclassify some of the FY22 contingency budget into FY22 expenditure line items.

Half way through the year it is necessary to make some adjustments to move some of the budgeted contingency up into several expense line items, including capital and training, to allow for unforeseen expenditures which occurred since the budget plan was developed. Chairman Castaneda motioned to approve the proposed budget reclassifications as set forth by the Fire Chief. Director Haffner seconded. *Motion carried unanimously*, 3:0.
