Vice-Chairman Bauer motioned to approve the Consent Agenda. Director Armendarez seconded. Motion carried unanimously, 3:0.

Incidents covered under the Fire Recovery agreement are non-District resident motor vehicle accidents, car fires and house fires. We have not increased the mitigation rates since 2010. Vice-Chairman Bauer motioned to approve Resolution 2022-03 authorizing the implementation of current allowable mitigation rates for Fire Recovery. Director Armendarez seconded. *Motion carried unanimously*, 3:0.
