The general consensus of the Board was to open the interest period for another month to gain as much input as possible from the public, and be prepared to appoint someone at the next meeting. Director Horch motioned to repost the interest period for 29 days (through November 17, 2015) and make an appointment at the November Board meeting, with Open Meeting law information being distributed as each Letter of Interest is received. - Regarding Station 191, we may have to consider using another facility rather than the Halberg center for storing and accumulating items for the annual Adopt-a-Family program.

- Chairman Castaneda attended the Fallen Firefighters Dedication at the State Capitol. It was a moving event and was well attended. Brief discussion ensued regarding acquiring a District flag with our logo.
