Regional Facility Transport Protocol Summary

As a reminder, in Southern Arizona, we have (6) regional triage protocols. You should use these, as you already do, for making ED destination decisions (regular or free-standing).

1. Critical Peds:

- 1. Inclusion: Age < 14 y/o with altered level of consciousness, respiratory distress, or shock/hemodynamic instability
- 2. Destination: BUMC-TC or TMC

2. Trauma Patients:

- Inclusion: trauma and SAEMS regional Anatomic, Physiologic, or Mechanism criteria
- 2. Destination:
 - 1. Anatomic or Physiology Criteria —> Level I (BUMC-TC)
 - 2. Mechanism criteria only or Comorbid factors —> closest appropriate trauma center: BUMC-SC, BUMC-TC

3. Cardiac Arrest:

- 1. Inclusion: Adult, cardiac arrest with return of spontaneous circulation
- 2. Destination: NWMC, OVMC, SMH, BUMC-TC, BUMC-SC, VA, TMC, SJH

4. STEMI:

- 1. Inclusion: STEMI on ECG
- 2. Destination: NWMC, OVMC, SMH, BUMC-TC, BUMC-SC, VA, TMC, SJH

5. Stroke - CVA/TIA

- 1. Inclusion: Cincinnati Stroke Scale (+), onset < 24hr
- 2. Destination: NWMC, OVMC, SMH, BUMC-TC, BUMC-SC, VA, TMC, SJH

6. High-Risk OB

- 1. Inclusion: Preterm labor (< 37 weeks), fetal demise, premature rupture of membranes, placenta prove, placenta abruption, prolapsed cord
- 2. Destination: NWMC, SJH, BUMC-TC, TMC
