CARONDELET, AVFD, and TPFD EMT ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPHRINE ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINE: ADULT AGE 15 OR OLDER

This AG is approved for use by an EMT-Basic that is approved to administer an Epinephrine IM Treatment by the District and the District's Medical Director after receiving initial training and completing a skills lab every year

INCLUSION

This AG can be used on adult patients (age 15 and older) that meet the Inclusion Criteria for the following Administrative Guidelines:

o Bronchospasm (due to Asthma and Obstructive Lung Disease)

o Anaphylaxis and Allergic Reaction – If respiratory distress with wheezing

EXCLUSION

This AG cannot be used on patients under the age of 15 nor any patient excluded in the following Administrative Guidelines::

o Bronchospasm (due to Asthma and Obstructive Lung Disease) o Anaphylaxis and Allergic Reaction

* Patients that receive Epinephrine IM need to have a follow-up ALS assessment with an ALS transport.
