Chief Klein highlighted the following items:

• The District has made contingent offers of employment to 3 people. They are in the process of completing the pre-employment process.

- All of the Battalion Chiefs have received approval from the State Fire School to serve as instructors for certification courses.
- Our Type 6 deployed several times in the last month and our tender is currently out on assignment.
- The new ambulance is in service at Station 191

Chairman Castenada inquired about the MOU with the Local 4462. President Gillmore responded that they anticipate extending the MOU Agreement.

- 9) Review, Discussion and possible Action to approve Resolution 2024-03 Relating to the Intergovernmental Agreement with Northwest Fire District for Emergency Dispatching Services. Assistant Chief Klein addressed the Board sharing that every year the District signs an agreement with Northwest Fire District for dispatch services. This agreement will be for a five-year period with an automatic 2% increase for each year within the contract term. After no further discussion, Chairman Castaneda motioned to approve Resolution 2024-03 concerning the Intergovernmental Agreement with Northwest Fire District for Emergency Dispatching Services. Director Neilson seconded. Motion carried unanimously, 3:0.
- 10) Review, Discussion and possible Action to approve the April 2024 Financial Reports and authorize the Chairman and Clerk to sign the Certificate of Review. Director Neilson motioned to approve the April 2024 financial reports and authorize the Chairman and Clerk to sign the Certificate of Review. Vice-Chairman Armendarez seconded. Motion carried unanimously, 3:0.
- 11) Review, Discussion and possible Action to adopt the Preliminary FY25 Budget including the tax levy rate of \$3.75 and the bond levy rate of \$ .58. Assistant Chief Klein addressed the Board commenting that the Proposed FY25 Budget submitted is legally

balanced, contains conservative revenue projections and includes a full staffing model, as well as incorporates the new payscale which was previously approved for implementation on July 1, 2024. After brief discussion, Director Neilson motioned to adopt the Proposed FY25 Budget including the tax levy rate of \$3.75 and the bond levy rate of \$ .58, and to direct staff to post it as required by law in preparation for the Public Hearing and final adoption at the June Board meeting. Vice-Chairman Armendarez seconded.

Motion carried unanimously, 3:0.
