

# **FIREWORKS USE AND SAFETY**

## **ILLEGAL CONSUMER FIREWORKS**

***ALL AERIAL AND EXPLODING FIREWORKS ARE ILLEGAL IN ARIZONA.***

These types of fireworks are subject to confiscation and/or citation.

Examples: sky or bottle rockets, firecrackers and aerial fireworks.

## **FIREWORKS USAGE**

Under Arizona law, firework usage is permitted on 27 days of the year, around specific holidays.

USE of legal consumer fireworks is allowed only on the following dates:

May 4 – May 6

June 24 – July 6

December 24 – January 3

SALE of legal consumer fireworks is allowed only on the following dates:

April 25 – May 6

May 20 – July 6

December 10 – January 3

*The sale and use of novelties known as snappers, party poppers, flow worms, toy smoke devices and sparklers **are permitted at all times.***

***Permissible consumer fireworks may NOT be sold to persons under sixteen (16) years of age.***

illuminating torches

wheels

ground spinners

flitter sparklers

toy smoke devices

wire sparklers or dipped sticks
