*Pursuant to the Arizona Open Meeting Laws, the Fire Board may only discuss matters listed on the Agenda. At the conclusion of the Call To The Public, the Fire Board may respond to criticism made by an individual who has addressed the Fire Board, may ask the Fire Chief to review the matter or to follow up on a matter, or may ask that a matter be placed on a future agenda. However, the Fire Board will not discuss or take action on any matter raised during a Call To The Public unless the matter is on the Agenda. **If you wish to address the Fire Board**, please complete a Speaker Card (located on table by entrance door) and give it to the Chairperson. Please indicate on the Speaker Card which agenda item or other issue you wish to speak on during the Call To The Public. The Fire Board may limit the time allocated for each speaker. The Fire Board may decide to hear all speakers during the Call To The Public or may hear those desiring to speak regarding a specific agenda item at a time to coincide with the regular agenda. **When called to speak, please do the following:** State your name and address for the record. If speaking on a specific agenda item, limit your discussion to that agenda item. Limit your comments to the amount of time allocated by the Fire Board. Conduct yourself in a courteous and respectful manner.*

8) **Chief's Report**

The Fire Chief may update the Board on items of interest relating to but not limited to the following: Response times, vehicles, facilities, labor relations, personnel, finance, grants, communications and/or training. Alternatively, the Fire Chief may provide written comments in the Board Member's packets or by email. The Board Members may ask clarifying questions and they may direct the Chief to place items on future agendas for further discussion or action.

9) **Review, Discussion and possible Action** to approve the May 2021 Financial Reports and authorize the Chairman and Clerk to sign the *Certificate of Review*.

10) Public Hearing on Proposed FY22 Budget

Pursuant to A.R.S. 48-805 and 48-807, The Avra Valley Fire District through its Board of Directors, has prepared an annual budget that contains detailed estimated expenditures for the fiscal year and clearly shows salaries payable to employees of the District, including the Fire Chief. In accordance with State statute, the *FY22 Proposed Budget* was posted in four public places and on the District's website for twenty days prior to holding this Public Hearing for the purpose of adopting said budget. Copies of the budget have also been made available to members of the public upon written request to the District. Following the Public Hearing, the District Board may adopt the budget, whereafter a complete copy of the *Adopted FY22 Budget* shall be posted in a prominent location on the District's official website within seven business days and shall be retained on the website for at least sixty months.

11) **Review, Discussion and possible Adoption** of the FY22 Budget including the adoption of the secondary property tax levy of \$3.50 and the bond repayment levy of \$.60 or other levy amounts as determined by the Board of Directors

12) **Executive Session** regarding an Intergovernmental Agreement for Shared Services Between Avra Valley Fire District and Three Points Fire District, and Executive Session regarding annual evaluation of the Fire Chief's performance and employment agreement. The Board may vote to go into executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for legal advice with the District's attorney on matters pertaining to an Intergovernmental Agreement for Shared Services Between Avra Valley Fire District and Three Points Fire District.

Pursuant to A.R.S. section 38-431.03(A)(1), the Governing Board may vote to enter Executive Session for discussion and consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, salary, benefits, discipline, or dismissal of Fire Chief Brian Delfs. Chief Delfs has been notified as required by law and he has waived his right to request that deliberations be held during a meeting open to the public.
